# Blurred Borders Queensland is a set of resources to help you talk about the law with clients and community members.

Two kits are available - bail and criminal process (including youth justice) and family violence.

## Each kit includes:

- ⦿ process maps
- ⦿ wallet cards
- ⦿ stickers
- ⦿ a user manual.



## The kits

- ⦿ use images, storytelling and plain language to help you break down complex legal concepts and explain processes step-by-step
- ⦿ help clients to better understand their legal rights, court obligations and participate in their legal process
- ⦿ support trauma informed practice
- ⦿ are culturally appropriate for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people.

The Blurred Borders Queensland tool kits have been designed for frontline service providers helping people engaged in Queensland's justice system.
